## Researching 20th Century New Jersey Families



Presentation by Melissa A. Johnson, CG, of *Johnson Genealogy Services, LLC*

Learn about resources and strategies for tracing ancestors and families who lived in New Jersey during the twentieth century. City directories, newspapers, maps, wills, deeds, vital records, military records, court records, naturalizations, state census records, and numerous other sources will be covered.

# Directions and Parking

The entrance to the Alexander Library is on College Avenue.

## Directions to Route 18 and New Brunswick

### Garden State Parkway—Southbound

- GS Parkway Exit 129 to NJ Turnpike South
- Take NJ Turnpike Exit 9, bear right after the toll plaza and follow signs for “Route 18 North—New Brunswick”
- Stay left to continue on Route 18 North  
*Continue with “Directions from Route 18 to Parking Deck,”*

### Garden State Parkway—Northbound

- GS Parkway Exit 105 and follow signs for “Route 18 North”
- Continue on Route 18 North for about 30 miles  
*Continue with “Directions from Route 18 to Parking Deck,”*

### New Jersey Turnpike—North or South

- NJ Turnpike Exit 9, bear right after the toll plaza and follow the signs for “Route 18 North—New Brunswick”
- Stay to the left for Route 18 North  
*Continue with “Directions from Route 18 to Parking Deck,”*

### Route 287—Southbound (from Morristown)

- Take Exit 9 for River Road toward Bound Brook/Highland Park
- Turn right onto River Road
- Merge onto Route 18 South to New Brunswick  
*Continue with “Directions from Route 18 to Parking Deck,”*

### Route 287—Northbound (from Edison/Staten Island)

- Take Exit 8 for Possumtown Road toward Highland Park/Middlesex
- Turn right onto Possumtown Road
- Turn left onto Centennial Avenue
- Turn right onto Route 18 south to New Brunswick  
*Continue with “Directions from Route 18 to Parking Deck,”*

## Directions from Route 18 to Parking Deck

Take the “George Street—College Ave Campus” exit:

- **Route 18 North > George Street Exit Ramp**—Turn right at the top of the exit ramp onto George Street, then left into Parking Deck.
- **Route 18 South > George Street Exit Ramp**—Continue straight onto George Street, then turn right into Parking Deck.

## Special Event Parking

**Free Special Event Parking:** Available in the **College Avenue Parking Deck** and in **Rutgers Lots 30 and 26**, entered from Sicard Street (Lot 30) or from Bartlett Street (spaces in Lot 26 without meters).

**MANDATORY (New):** You must pre-register your vehicle for Free Special Event Parking to avoid a parking citation. The link for vehicle registration will be provided to you via email after you register for the Annual Meeting.

**Paid Street Parking:** As an alternative, limited street parking is available on Senior Street and other streets bordering Lot 30. Parking meter rates are in effect. All non-metered street parking is restricted to city permit holders—citations are issued to violators.
